From Stefan, South Korea

Acts 18:9 “Then spake the Lord to Paul in the night by a vision, Be not afraid, but speak, and hold not thy peace: 18:10 For I am with thee, and no man shall set on thee to hurt thee: for I have much people in this city.”

So who should we speak to?

Acts 17:17 “Therefore disputed he in the synagogue with the Jews, and with the devout persons, and in the market daily with them that met with him.”

I came to SangJu yesterday and have found some places to meet with people. Met today with the taxi driver's as they waited for customers. A group of taxi drivers asked "what country are you from ? Instead of saying the USA I said the country that has two horns like a lamb and speaks like a dragon. One man moved his head from side to side and thought a few moments then he said Norway, I said no then he said Kyrgyzstan or Pakistan.

Then I had a chance to explain why the USA was referred to as having 2 horns like a lamb and speaks like a dragon. Another man later asked where are you from and I asked him to guess the country with 2 horns like a lamb etc he said Denmark. This afternoon I found a great place in the downtown area at a 4-way intersection. Throughout our life we have heard sermons that were 30 or 60 or even 90 minutes long While the people are waiting at the red light to cross the street they get a 30 or 60 or 90 second sermon.

Most of the time when we are driving or walking across the street we like green lights but for red light street preachers green lights are a curse and red lights are a blessing in disguise. When the light turns green people are free to walk and most people just walk away. But tonight a group of 6 junior high school young girls stayed for a long time. While the folks are looking at the red light waiting for it to turn green I ask them "Is this red light blocking and restricting our liberty and happiness or protecting our life? Then tell them if you cross the street when it is red you could get injured or even killed. Then I switch to God's law of liberty and tell them that when the God of liberty says "thou shalt not" it is not to restrict our liberty but to protect our life.

Red light intersection preaching is wonderful, learning how to speak fast before the cursed green light comes.

“There are many places in which the voice of the minister cannot be heard, places which can be reached only by our publications, -- the books, papers, and tracts filled with the Bible truths that the people need. Our literature is to be distributed everywhere. The truth is to be sown beside all waters; for we know not which will prosper, this, or that. In our erring judgment we may think it unwise to give literature to the very ones who would accept the truth the most readily.
