Took my Chinese flute out to Oak Chun on Sunday and played the hymn “His eye is on the sparrow”.

Then I read these verses in Korean

Luk 7:32 They are like children sitting in the marketplace and calling to each other, saying, ‘We played the flute for you, and you didn’t dance. We sang a dirge, and you didn’t weep.’

Nobody started dancing but I did get their attention.

Went to the stadium to walk and have noon prayer like Daniel and met Mr Shin (see picture) he had lived 6 years in Saudi Arabia

Sitting in the market meeting people is always a blessing.

Told them the whole story of Noah and the mocking world and the flood with all the details before the flood no rain only dew and the animals filing into the ark and Noah’s final appeal and the door being shut and 7 days of no rain and the people having a carnival outside of the ark then the rain starting and the flood waters rising and the people pounding on the door of the ark asking for entrance but it was too late.
