From Stefan, South Korea

I have a free airplane ticket on Korean airlines that I have to use or it will disappear, so instead of going to China decided to come to Je Ju Island off the coast of the Korean peninsula. So flew from Cheng Ju to Je Ju City only about a 50 minute flight. The Cheng Ju airport is also a military airport. As we were about to take off 2 F-16 fighter jets were right out side my window. In the fasten seat belt announcement time the stewardess especially mentioned taking pictures of the military airport is illegal, I had a strong temptation to take a picture but the Lord gave me the victory.

When we landed going to the airport in a small bus I asked a couple near by what were those lights out in the sea, the man did not know either but he spoke quite good English. A few minutes later at the luggage pick up place met them again ,they had just the day before gotten married and were on their honeymoon, so gave them a big congratulations and offered them a Korean version of the Yesterday Today and Forever book as a wedding gift. He is a smoker and on the front of the book it says "Courage, hope, faith, sympathy, love, promote health and prolong life". He had lived for 8 years in Sidney and came back to Korea to get a bride and now to find Christ the pearl of great price.

This week have been doing canvassing work and the Lord is opening many doors.

"The canvassing work, properly conducted, is missionary work of the highest order, and it is as good and successful a method as can be employed for placing before the people the important truths for this time..... . Today went to an office that trained architects , it had a big class room with two offices went to one office and the man was busy and sorta rude no time not interested etc, was tempted to just go but decided to go to the other office the man was just getting ready to leave, i could see by his skin that he was a smoker so told him i use to smoke but was liberated, got my emancipation from nicotine, showed him my books, he said i will give you three minutes to talk, so we went to another room to sit down and showed him the books he said these are religious books how can they help me to quit smoking, so told him Mr Go his name is also the same as my Korean name Go, actually this island

has many many people with the family name Go. 高 Mr Go imagine an empty bottle of water filled with air, the air represents your smoking habit, if you turn the bottle upside down and shake it for half an hour it will still have air inside, if you put a straw in it to suck out the air ,it will still have air, but if you pour water in the air goes out. Jesus said If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink. Mr Go by buying and reading this book you will be filling your soul with living water.

He bought two books. As we walked out of the office together, he showed me his empty pack of cigarettes and said he was on his way to the store to buy some cigarettes right when i showed up talking about being liberated from nicotine. Told him" Mr Go this was a providence of God, please read the book. Went by another shop where the man was slumbering in his chair with the TV on,



went and woke him up and told him my name, he has the same family name as Confucius 孔。 He had quite rosy cheeks so I assumed he was a non smoker but come to find out he smoked 4 packs a day. I told him if you smoke one pack a day it is 1,640,000 Won per year. So i asked us both what is 1,640,000 times 4 ? We could not not figure it out in our heads so he whipped out his calculator and said 6,560,000 Won.

I had one hard cover very nice copy of Christ Object lessons so shewed him the book and said Mr Confucius this book does not cost 6,000,000 Won or even 3 million or even one Million but just 30,000 from 6 million to 30,000 seemed so cheap he immediately bought the book. Pray for Mr Confucius and the island of JeJu.
