After thinking a moment all three of them blurted out, love thy neighbor as thy self.

Still showing them my ten fingers I showed how our ten fingers shrink down into our two arms, and told them how Jesus worded the 10 into 2. So the second great commandment would be “love thy neighbor as thy self”.
