While on vacation in New Hampshire, Julia and I were able to attend an afternoon meeting on Sabbath that meets near Portland, ME. It is a more conservative type of Adventist group that does not want to be considered an offshoot or create conflict with the surrounding morning church services, so it holds an afternoon service every Sabbath at 2pm. Only a handful of members that attend are non-trinitarian.

A non-trinitarian friend and also a board member of this group showed me around the facility when I got there and explained that it was a health center that the owner just recently purchased from a person who had recently passed away. He also explained that not everyone was non-trinitarian but that he and a few others were working with people on a one-to-one basis to witness to them about the fraudulent trinity. He also told me that the speaker's topic was going to be about the trinity and that he was a trinitarian!

At the beginning of his sermon, he let people know that the floor would be open for questions and comments during his presentation. In the first 10 minutes alone, I heard him mention three things that were in error. But I patiently waited for someone else to break the ice and speak first. It wasn't long before my friend made a comment about some error that the pastor had said. Now I felt more comfortable to start speaking up :))

To make a long story short, I was able to read quite a few Sop quotes and Bible verses, which I had with me on my phone, that the pastor was unable to refute. I also had the undivided attention of approximately 35 people that were there, some with questions about the trinity, wondering what the big deal was with the whole thing. God was definitely using me through His spirit to convey the truth about the trinity.

After the meeting, I was in the kitchen eating a meal with a bunch of them and some began asking me questions about the trinity. As I was answering them, the whole room was quietly listening to me speak. Again, the holy spirit was working through me, bringing to my remembrance the answers to everything that was asked! Praise God!! I was able to give out some of our literature also.

The sister that got baptised during our annual camp is named Di lo. Her mum is now a widow and she's struggling in trying to support her 4 kids in their teens.

The church has been visiting them and doing shopping for her family and we pick them up every sabbath and take them to church.

Sister Ani from Savusavu donated 1,000 dollars to start building the church here in the country side .

We have send some money to pay for the boat



fare for workers who will come to build the church and they will be arriving on Thursday this week.

We were saving 800 dollars to buy some off cuts and to build my kitchen in the farm but we just found out that the car is due for test again next week.

It's quite costly when car goes for a examination before it's passed to run again so we will do that now and my kitchen later. But it's just once in a year they do that to all vehicles in Fiji but not sure in other countries.

Well, I'm just writing this to you but not as a testimony but maybe Ani's donation for the church can be a testimony.

Eddie is planning to travel to the outer island so he might be away for 3weeks or a month due to the schedule of ferries. His planning to travel in the month of February God willing.

It's quite far to travel by boat but by plane is faster but expensive.

Coffee compost and the unfallen worlds

In Korea women keep their family name even after marriage. So the family is comprised of Mr Lee and his wife Mrs Choi and their 3 children Jenny, Sunny and Billy. They own a small coffee shop in Bo Eun called Hashtag. They save their coffee grounds for me so we can make compost for our vegetable gardens. Stopped by today for the coffee grounds and the 17 year old daughter Jenny was there. (See picture of Jenny and the coffee grounds)

She said our family is moving to Osan in two weeks. We talked for a while then I said "Jenny I want to show you something in the Scriptures, so opened my North Korean Bible to Luke 15 and we read together the parable of the one lost sheep. Asked her what she thought the lost sheep was? She hummed and hawwed a moment. Then told her the one lost sheep was our planet and the 99 sheep represented all the other worlds in the universe. Acquainted her with the reality that these other worlds have no Corona virus or wars no death, pain sorrow or crying. Then we read together John 3:16 & 17 and put stress on the word so, God soooooooooooooo loved the world that He gave (not loaned) His only begotten Son.....

I am experimenting with opening the Scriptures to people



based on this from DA.

"They were to enter the dwelling with the beautiful salutation, "Peace be to this house." Luke 10:5. That home would be blessed by their prayers, their songs of praise, and the opening of the Scriptures in the family circle.{DA 351.3} "

Here in Korea now that CV has come, at most homes when going door to door we just talk at the door, but yesterday after my noon prayer on the roof of an apartment on my way down stopped at the first resident on the 3rd floor an old lady came to the door we chatted for a few seconds then she said come in, they were just finishing lunch and invited me to eat so politely declined and we all sat cross legged on the floor as is the custom here in Korea. The 3 of us the 97 year old mother and her 60 year old son. I said "Peace be to your house", the man gave me a hearty thank you. Come to find out he has liver cancer and has already had 4 surgeries and the 5th one is scheduled for next week. He is a Mr Lee as are millions here in Korea and a Presbyterian Christian. Opened the Scriptures to him also and read Rev 14:6 "And I saw another angel fly in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach unto them that dwell on the earth, and to every nation, and kindred, and tongue, and people", then asked him what he thought the everlasting gospel was, he said Jesus, then I enumerated on his Jesus answer to say that Jesus died on Calvary between two thieves and they both mocked him in the beginning but later on one changed his mind. While one thief said "If you are the Christ come down from the cross and save us and yourself", the other thief rebuked him and said "we deserve what we get but this man has done nothing amiss." So the thief that felt his need confessed his sin and cast himself on the mercy of Jesus and said "Lord, remember me when thou comest into thy kingdom" to which Jesus said "Verily I say unto thee Today, shalt thou be with me in paradise."

Statistics show that young people are more likely to respond to the gospel than older folks and also that sick people more readily agree with the conditions of salvation than those that are whole. Please pray for 17 year old Jenny and 60 year old sick Mr Lee.

Dear RM,

Receive our Sabbath greetings in God our Father and Jesus the only begotten Son of our Heavenly Father. We are doing well here dear brethren. The work has resumed after six days of Bible workers conference. Brethren learned many things in those days. End time truth we need to be taking in every corner was the theme of the conference. We started by studying about the three angels message found in Revelation 14:6-12, this is the end time message we are carrying everywhere as we open people’s eyes by exposing errors in Christianity today.

We have a message to save souls. A message to be taken in difference places. Apart from the three angels message, we reminded ourselves and studied about the law, (both moral and ceremonial laws), trinity (how trinity affects man’s relationship with our Heavenly Father, the root of trinity, and how this trinity is destroying God’s people), we studied about the Sabbath, (how the Sabbath is a sign between us and God, how to keep the Sabbath holy, how to present Sabbath truth to Sunday worshippers and bible evidence about the church of apostles keeping Sabbath holy), We studied also about what are happening in the world and how to get people ready.
